

Special Issue of the Third Croatian Conference on Earthquake Engineering in Advances in Civil and Architectural Engineering Journal

The Scientific Committee of 3CroCEE and the journal Advances in Civil and Architectural Engineering invite submissions of papers addressing topics pertinent to the journal's scope and effectively presented at 3CroCEE.

To avert similarity between a conference paper and a journal paper, the subsequent criteria must be fulfilled: A journal version must include a minimum of 30% new content (novel theories, ideas, supplementary experiments, or comprehensive data, results, and discussions), must reference the conference paper, and must feature a new title and abstract in accordance with COPE guidelines. Upon submission, the paper will undergo a double-blind revision process, identical to the peer review procedure for other articles in the ACAE journal. There are no Article Processing Charges (APCs) for authors of published papers in a Special Issue submission to the journal ACAE.

Manuscripts may be submitted immediately upon the opening of the Special Issue. Manuscripts submitted to Special Issues are published upon acceptance, irrespective of the publication date of the Special Issue. Upon acceptance, the papers are forwarded to the journal's production department. Accepted papers with active DOIs will be promptly accessible online on the corresponding Special Issue page and the journal's table of contents.

Manuscripts featured in Special Issues are indexed identically to articles published in the journal's regular issues. They will be listed in the pertinent databases (WOS and Scopus) where the journal is indexed.

Post-deadline, the Special Issue will cease to accept new submissions; however, articles will persist in being published as manuscripts progress through the review process.

The finalised Special Issue will be located under "Published Special Issues" on the journal's website. If a Special Issue is cancelled due to fewer than six papers, all manuscripts under consideration and those already published will be transferred to the journal's regular issue.
